We had a pool-view bure which also looked out onto beautiful Natadola Beach, the best white sandy beach on the Coral Coast. The bure was well appointed, had a very comfortable bed and Pure Fiji products for use in the bathroom. Three one hour massages for FJ\$100 was an absolute bonus at the Spa. The staff were very friendly and efficient, yet laid-back and we thoroughly enjoyed the relaxed 'barefoot chic' feeling of the resort. Dinner had fresh fish, salads, Kokoda, seafood, curries, pasta, steak and chicken to choose from and there were 5 delicious dessert options.

There's been a lot happening at Aga Reef Resort over the last month or so.

- 1 Whilst there's great snorkelling to be had here, the resorts currently seeking MAF's help in looking at ways to improve marine life in the Lalomanu Coastal waters by reproducing growing coral via fragmentation. This will also include the provision of other marine life species such as giants clams.
- 2 The resort is currently working on offering additional activities for their guests and coming on line soon will be a purpose built petanque court.
- 3 Our guests are loving the cocktails served up at the resort. Our very own mixologist, Albert Schmidt knows how to blend these to perfection & recently came second in the Signature Cocktail Competition at the Teuila Festival with his creation.
