ROUND RAROTONGA ORIENTATION TOUR

PROGRESSIVE DINNER THROUGH LOCAL HOMES

Leave the familiar surrounds of your resort and venture out to the villages to experience true Cook Islands cuisine, hospitality and the real spirit of culture and lifestyle when you visit the locals in their homes. Enjoy three-courses with each course in a different local home. Explore the tropical garden that the host of the first course has to offer before travelling to your main course where you will be treated to a buffet feast, similar to what you'd expect at a large Cook Islands family gathering. Then your dessert host will delight you with local sweets and fruit as well as tea & Atiu Island brewed coffee. Whilst enjoying your meal at each home, you'll be delighted by the sounds of local ukuleles, guitar and voices of the small string band that will accompany you throughout your local dining experience.

AVARUA HISTORICAL WALKING TOUR

Put on your walking shoes & join us on this informative walking tour. The Avarua Historical Walking Tour is a 1½ hour leisurely paced guided walk through the historical parts of Avarua. The tour is conducted by our knowledgeable guide who will trace the Cook Islands history from Polynesian settlement of Rarotonga to the discovery and colonisation by New Zealand administration, the missionaries and through to independence. The tour concludes at a nearby beach setting with fruits and juice refreshments. You'll need to arrive 15 minutes early, wear comfortable walking shoes, bring water and wear sun protection.

Duration: 1½ hours (make your own way to Trader Jacks for a start at 3.00 pm)

Days of Operation: Monday / Wednesday / Friday

Cost: NZ\$60 per adult/ NZ\$45 per child (4-12 years inclusive)
